Example 2 – Calculation with basic points

Tom Smith serves as an Ex-Co member of The Business Students' Union for the Academic Year 2023-24. He will be serving the same position and joining the Residential Life Team of Hall VI in the upcoming Academic Year 2024-25. He should declare all the positions at hall application for Residential Year 2024-25 in order to gain hall points under this section.

If Tom is a Local Student,

Example 3 – Calculation with higher points by nomination

Tom Smith serves as an Ex-Co member of The Business Students' Union for the Academic Year 2023-24. He will be serving the same position and joining the Residential Life Team of Hall VI in the upcoming Academic Year 2024-25. Both The Business Students' Union and Residential Life Team agreed to nominate Tom for higher points. He should declare all the positions at hall application for Residential Year 2024-25 in order to gain hall points under this section.

If Tom is a Local Student,

Points to Note:

Total Max Points for Local Students is 25 and Total Max Points for Non-Local / No-Home-Base Students is 50; therefore the total points gained will only be the maximum point once reached.

Example 4 – Calculation with change of declaration status

Tom Smith is a Local Student who will be serving as an Ex-co member of The Business Students' Union for the Academic Year 2024-25. He has declared the position at hall application for Residential Year 2024-25 and the hall points gained under this section are 10 points.

At the time of hall application,

Roles to be counted	Points Gained	Ratio	Total Points

However, he **quits** the stated position before the hall check-in date, which leads to the gained **10 hall points** under this section being **retrieved**.

With the 10 points retrieved, his total hall points including the points gained from other sections (e.g. travelling time, outstanding achievement, etc.) become lower than the cut-off points of that residential year, and Tom's hall offer will be recovered.

Tom may remain on the wait list for future hall availability.

Points to Note:

Hall points gained from Leadership and Contribution to Campus Life will be recovered if the applicant leaves the position in the middle of the term, possibly leading to recovery of the hall offers given.
